Name of Task	Propaganda Source Analysis	Short Answer Test	Research & Extended Response	Visual/ Digital representation
Brief Description	In-class task: Part A- Multiple Choice- Students analyse WWI enlistment propaganda sources (taught in class during the topic); and demonstrate their understanding in multiple choice questions. In-class task: Part B- Short answer response- Students will select ONE WWI enlistment propaganda poster and draft a short answer response arguing why it would have been the most effective propaganda poster. Students will then write a final version during the in- class task.	In-class test: Part A- Multiple Choice- Students examine and interpret primary data and secondary sources (geographical tools) representing factors influencing human wellbeing; to demonstrate geographical skills in multiple choice questions. In-class test: Part B- Short answer responses- Students write short answer responses to demonstrate their understanding.	 Research: Students research and select relevant historical sources/ evidence to substantiate an extended response on child labour/ slavery in either Trans-Atlantic Slave period or the modern-day era (student choice). Extended Response: Students integrate 2x examples of historical sources/ evidence into an Ext. TEEEC paragraph explaining the impact of slavery on a particular time period (past or present). 	Visual or Digital representation: Students research geographical information and data on international migration to Australia; and create a visual or digital representation of Australia's multicultural identity- either promoting Australia as an ideal new start to migrants OR representing the contribution of migrants to the development of Australia.
