

LINCROON SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Lincron Senior scholarship has been set up to assist two students to achieve their goals as they undertake their senior studies of Years 11 and 12. The scholarship is open to any Kurri Kurri High School Student who is commencing Year 11 in 2022.

The recipients must show initiative as well as have a desire to complete their HSC. This scholarship is not based on academic achievement but rather someone who displays promise and determination. Central to the application is that they are in a position that without the assistance of these funds, they may not be able to achieve this goal and reach their full potential.

The value of the scholarship is \$1000 and is to be administered over two years. A resubmission is not required at the end of each year; however attendance will be monitored and considered at the end of the first year, as this is key to the scholarship conditions. You will also work with a mentor over the period of the scholarship who will assist with the budgeting of the scholarship, provide general support for you here at school and help you reach your goals.

ELIGIBILITY

The scholarship is available to any student commencing Year 11 in 2022 and will be completing Year 12 in 2023.

SELECTION

Applicants for the scholarship must complete and submit the application form by: 2.30pm Monday, 15th November 2021 and deliver to Mrs St Hill - Deputy Principal.

A Selection Committee will assess all eligible applications and the recipients announced at the Annual Awards Assembly.

The Selection Committee will be comprised of members of the School Executive.

The Selection Committee has the right to look at your most recent report and attendance record in the selection process.

CONDITIONS OF THE AWARD

The scholarship shall be for two years and shall be taken up for Years 11 and 12.

The recipient must be prepared to work with a mentor for the duration of the scholarship to monitor the way in which funds are being used and to assist the student reach their goals.

The recipient must attend school on a daily basis with all absences being able to be accounted for due to illness or school business.

If there are any residual funds at the end of the scholarship period, the funds are non-transferable and will remain in a scholarship trust to contribute to future scholarships.

BENEFIT

The scholarship provides \$1000 to a student and shall be kept in trust at the school. In consultation with your mentor, funds can be accessed in the following ways:

- i) Payment can be made directly to a supplier on your behalf i.e. for tutoring or purchase of resources. A written quote or invoice must be provided along with a completed Funds Request Form.
 - ii) We make payment to you for pre-approved purchases that you make. In order to receive reimbursement you must complete a Funds Request Form and provide copies of all receipts.
 - iii) Funds can be used to cover the costs of the following items:
 - School excursions
 - School stationery
 - Textbooks
 - Course costs i.e. items required to complete a major work project
 - School uniform – as set out in the school handbook
 - Private Tutoring
 - Laptop to be used at school
 - Wellbeing i.e. yoga classes, gym classes
- N.B. A limit will be placed on some of these spending areas to avoid misuse of funds

Please be aware that it can take up to 5 working days to receive funds. Funds will be transferred to a nominated bank account.

TERMINATION

A scholarship shall terminate before its due date of conclusion if the recipient:

- i) Fails to attend school to a satisfactory level without medical reason or attending school business.
- ii) Ceases to be a student of Kurri Kurri High School.
